\$200 Scholarship L153 a/b Sergeijs and Olesja are siblings who really like school. He likes Home EC best and she likes Visual Arts. They speak Russian/Latvian. He likes to draw cars and make them through woodworking. She likes to do Origami and sing and dance the Latvian National Dance while he does Hip Hop. She likes skiing and plays a game like volleyball, but they catch and throw the ball back and forth across the net and very popular in Latvia. He's a true sportsman and plays volleyball, running, discus, and floorball.



\$1650 Scholarship L154 a,b,c,d: Arturs, Alekss, Aina, and Dmitrijs are siblings who seem to get along well together. Both older boys, Arturs and Alekss enjoy math and sports in school. When asked what they would like to improve, they both shared they would like to learn more about God! Arturs (left) is the second oldest, likes to read and ride bikes. He says Aleks helps him with school work. Aleks, (right) is the oldest, he enjoys sports and playing with friends. He says Arturs is smarter, does sports better, and protects them. Aina and Dmitrijs both like pancakes and can count to 10 in English. Aina loves Barbies. Dmitrijs loves to play with cars and balls.

\$1650 Scholarship L160 Ivars, Diana, Aigars, Laura are from a very rural foster family. They are all very good kids! Laura, the oldest, likes Barbies and is the serious, artistic one of the bunch. Diana likes to play with her baby dolls and wishes for one with a stroller. Ivars, the oldest of the boys, likes soccer, ice hockey, and bike riding. He takes care of the pets and helps with the house. Aigars, the youngest, likes to play on the swings and trampoline. He would like an electronic game for Christmas. All kids are very shy and innocent and definitely NOT WORLDLY kids. They will be amazed at the simplest of things and most every hour in the beginning will be eye opening to them!



L129 Aleksandrs, age 6 is considered Special Needs. Has mild CP, but corrective heel/cord extension surgery already done and now walking and getting around perfect! Was preemie and small for his age! Delayed in learning, but he is capable and doing well! He was a little sad during our interview because he had just gotten a "boo-boo". After LeAnn fussed over it for a minute, he was much better. He is very friendly, and will usually "stick with" someone because he doesn't like to be alone. He is a good boy and doesn't cause trouble, but will stick up for himself!

What is Orphan Hosting?

Orphan hosting is inviting an orphan from another country to be a member of your family for a period of time. New Horizons for Children offers two Orphan Hosting Programs per year, 5-6 weeks in the summer and 4 weeks in the winter.

\$500 Scholarship U201 Denis was the favorite of his orphanage director, and she said he is a good kid that simply needs a family! He has won many awards from his sports activities, and loves basketball, running, and jumping. He likes doing any kinds of crafts, including drawing, cross stitch, and woodworking. He reads fairy tales and poems. He doesn't hurt little kids and would like a family with children of any age. Wishes? "Most of all, a family!"

\$1650 Scholarship L178 (left to right) Reinis 8 turning 9 and Linda 2, Ugis 8, Mareks 6, and Raivo 4. Reinis is a caring little daddy to the other 4. He is very gentle and likes to play soccer, can read well, is a fast runner and said he can throw a ball farther than anyone else. He likes dogs and cats, swimming and knew 3x12 instantly! He can't wait to ride in an airplane and visit the USA! Ugis likes dogs and cats, basketball and Russian ravioli and knew 5x4 as quick as we asked it! His favorite animal is a frog and he likes ice cream and can't wait to ride on an airplane with his brothers! Mareks likes soccer, basketball, cats better than dogs and can swim. His favorite color is red and riding in an airplane is also a dream! Raivo is the youngest boy and likes dogs and cats but is afraid of snakes! He likes to kick balls and eat ice cream and likes blue and red too! Linda is too young to travel, but must be considered in a "forever option" if a family chose to adopt later.

She is known as helpful and one who likes to help with small children. She speaks both Latvian and Russian and has studied English but is not able to speak much yet. In school, her favorite subject is music and her favorite color is light blue. She has had some issues in the past with stealing small things from her foster mom, but this has improved and she is highly recommended.

U213 Igor is to be considered as HOST ONLY and is a very nice and polite 15 year old boy, who came to America once before. He was only there for a few weeks, but says he loved everything! He liked riding on a boat, museums, bike riding, and swimming. He also loved eating steaks! He says he is not a risky person, but does try new things. He plays soccer, and is a ping pong champion at his school. His director says that he is funny and likes to be the center of attention and gets along with everyone!



L146 Miranda is friendly, very interested in our program and said her favorite subject in school is visual art. She also speaks both Latvian and Russian and enjoys drawing nature. She likes track and field events and has won awards in cross-country, but really wants to learn ballet as her friends do this. She likes cats and thinks maybe she would like to be a hair stylist when she grows up. She likes working and playing on computers but would really enjoy a "sporty" family if she had a choice.





U179 Anya was all smiles during our interview. She is a straight A student with more awards than we could count! She recently wrote an essay in school explaining Christmas and New Year's traditions in America and really wants to experience it first hand on our program! She also recites poetry and our team was just overall impressed by her openness and optimism! She likes to play volleyball and dodge ball and loves all dogs and cats. Her favorite color is red and she says she can cook too. She also loves small kids and helping to take care of them. She got a unanimous YES! from the interview team!



\$850 Scholarship U205 Oleksiy was calm, smiled easily and made great eye contact with our interview team. His orphanage director called him "sunshine in the window" and said he is such a happy and good boy! She also begged us to get him out of the orphanage and into a family before it's too late. He is kind, positive and a hard worker. He likes drawing, dancing, soccer, basketball, ping pong, roller blading, swimming and bike riding. When his interview was done, he gave the team a great big bunch of hugs, especially Stephanie! He would like to learn to ride BMX, and live in a big family. Professional ideas include: professional chauffeur or welder! LAST CHANCE, he will turn 16 in February!

\$800 Scholarship U195 Sergiy was shy and quiet, but also very comfortable, friendly and very sweet. He thoroughly enjoyed his time talking with us. He likes riding bikes, swimming, volleyball, soccer, basketball, and ping pong. He would like to learn tennis, English, American football and baseball...most kids we have to beg for one answer! He came up with a well thought out group of 4! He likes rabbits best of all animals but also likes all dogs and cats too. If he had 3 wishes for himself, he would first wish for school supplies he could donate to others, get some English books to improve and study English and some new cross stitch patterns for his friends and his class at school! He thinks he would like to study in a college and become a PE teacher someday. He said he prays for a family for himself and described a Christian camp he attended in Ukraine over summer. Described himself as funny and likes to play with small kids.



L155 Martins is 15 years old and is about to age out in February 2013. This is his last chance! His favorite subject is PE and he is a great boy with ZERO problems per his foster mom. He also likes soccer, basketball, volleyball and fishing. He would like to learn how to make fishing lures and wants to learn English. He is an excellent student and has earned many academic awards in school. When he grows up he wants to be a police officer because he would like to get into high speed chases catching bad guys! He is somewhat socially immature as compared to 15 year olds in America. But, it's all good and he is an adorable kid! At this foster home, he cuts the grass which he enjoys but really wishes he didn't have to do weeding. He also likes computers and while he couldn't think of some new gift he would like to receive, he thought his foster mom needs a car and would give her one if he could give her anything in the world!
